Have Tenant Sign Letter Withdrawing Complaint

Here's a sample letter from a tenant advising the DHCR that he is withdrawing his complaint and asking the DHCR to dismiss the case. If you're settling more than one complaint, have the tenant sign a separate letter for each complaint. Attach a copy of the letter to the settlement agreement—and send the original letter to the DHCR. If the tenant is represented by an attorney, get the tenant's attorney to sign the withdrawal letter along with the tenant.
